Will the **Prime Minister** be pleased to state the action Government have taken to counteract Peking's campaign to villify and misrepresent India?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of External Affairs (Shri Dinesh Singh): Government have made every endeavour to expose Peking's paganda against India. Factual formation about border developments has been given out to the Indian and foreign press regularly. Our Missions abroad have placed the facts of the border situation before the Governments to which they are accredited and also before the people of the countries concerned. A number publications explaining the systematic Chinese aggression against our territories have been distributed abroad in various languages. Regular bulletins by our Missions carry fullest information on border developments. All India Radio in its External vices has been broadcasting talks designed to counter Peking's paganda. A large volume of favourable comment has appeared in foreign press showing that Chinese propaganda against India has, by and large, not deceived people abroad. Government has also received expressions of sympathy and support from many countries providing further evidence that Chinese propaganda has failed in its attempt to misrepresent India as the aggressor in the present border situation.
