

(ii) Popular articles describing the techniques have been published in journals and newspapers for general public.

(iii) An Extension Cell has been set up for the extension of the techniques developed at the Institute through demonstration of experimental constructions. Field extension cells have been set up at Bhopal and Calcutta for implementation of the processes in actual construction projects.

(a) whether it is a fact that on the 16th April, 1965 Naga hostiles attacked the Police Station of Chandel Sub-division of Manipur bordering upper Burma;

(b) if so, the particulars thereof; and

(c) the action taken by Government in the matter?

The Minister of State in The Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri Hathi):

(a) to (c). According to the Manipur Administration, on the night of 16th April, 1965, Chandel Police heard two shots fired about four hundred yards away. They then fired five rounds. Nothing else took place.

Seizure of Chinese Literature

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to a news published in the Gujarat paper at Baroda that Government have seized communist literature despatched by Chinese Government through Pakistani agents; and

(b) if so, the Government's reaction thereto?

The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri L. N. Mishra):

(a) Yes Sir, but the news was not published in a Gujarat paper at Baroda but a Gujarati daily paper published from Ahmedabad. The report, however, was from Baroda.

(b) The persons found in possession of objectionable literature were arrested and released on bail. Investigation is in progress.
