

(2) the Sharavaty Hydro-electric Scheme, (Mysore State);

(3) the Transmission and Distribution Schemes of Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Punjab.

At the instance of this Ministry, the Iron and Steel Controller has agreed to accord over-riding priorities on Indian producers in some of these cases and to arrange for the import of various sections of steel in others. In particular, in respect of the steel plates which are required in large quantities for pen-stock pipes of hydro-electric projects, the indigenous production is well below the demand. It is proposed to import high-tensile steel plates in the current financial year. The position is being kept constantly under watch for prompt action at appropriate levels to help solve the difficulties.
