Shri M. M. Das: We have said that a few copies of the report have been received only last week. We have not yet gone through the whole of the report. It is a big, voluminous report, and it will take some time before we go through the report and take some decision on it.

श्री भक्त दर्शन : क्या माननीय मंत्री को यह ज्ञात है कि इस प्रश्न पर पिछले लगभग पांच या छः बर्षों से विचार किया जा रहा है और अभी तक केवल विचार ही किया जा रहा है ? इसलिये क्या इस सम्बन्ध में कुछ शीघ्रता से निर्णय करने का प्रयत्न किया जायेगा ?

Shri M. M. Das: The hon. Member may kindly realise that about these matters Government badly requires the help, advice and suggestions of the scientists of our country. A symposium was organised by the National Institute of Sciences, a private, non-official organisation. We have received their suggestions only last week. So, it will take some time

World Youth Organisation

*906. **Shri Raghunath Singh:** Will the Minister of Education and Scientific Research be pleased to state whether it is a fact that a convention of World Youth Organisation is going to be held in India in August, 1958?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research (Dr. K. L. Shrinani): The Government of India has no such

proposal; but it is understood from the India Committee of the World Assembly of Youth, that they propose to hold the next Session of the General Assembly of Youth, in India in August, 1958.

श्री रघुनाथ सिंह : मैं यह जानना चाहता हूँ कि सरकार की तरफ से हम प्रारम्भनाइजेशन को क्या सहायता प्राप्त होगी और कौन कौन देश हममें शामिल हो रहे हैं ?

डा० का० ला० श्रीमानी : जहाँ तक सरकार को मालूम है ५० देश इस संगठन में सम्मिलित हैं और मेरा क्याल है कि सभी देशों के प्रतिनिधि उपस्थित होंगे। सरकार से अभी निश्चित रूप से कोई सहायता नहीं मांगी गयी है और यह लिखा गया है कि कानफरेंस के मुतालिक जो ज्यादातर खर्चा होगा उसको यह संगठन ही बरदास्त करेगा।

श्री भक्त दर्शन : मैं यह जानना चाहता हूँ कि यह जो सम्मेलन किया जा रहा है इसमें 'युवक' की क्या परिभाषा होगी क्योंकि मास्को में जो युवक समारोह हुआ था उसमें बताया जाता है कि ५० और ५५ साल के लोग भी जवान समझे गये थे !

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: Need not be answered.

Shri Hem Barua: May I know if the invitations to the countries that will attend this World Youth Conference would conform to the composition of the U.N. membership or be according to the tenets of our foreign policy?

Dr. K. L. Shrinani: There is no question. This is a world assembly of youth and functions through national committees, and naturally the representatives of the organisations which are members of this organisation will participate in the conference.

Shri Panigrahi: The hon. Minister said that the particular youth organisation called the world Assembly of Youths is sponsoring this convention. May I know whether the countries

like the Soviet Union and other Democracies are being invited to this convention?

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: That would not be for the Government to say whether they would invite or not; it would be for the organisation.

Shri Panigrah: They have got a list, therefore I wanted to know.

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: Whether they would invite all of them or not would be for the organisation, not for the Government, to say.

Shri Vasudevan Nair: May I know whether this World Assembly has any affiliated national unit in India, and if so, what is their membership?

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: There are three organisations which are connected with this organisation: the AICC Youth Department, the Congress Seva Dal and the Akhil Hindu Yuvak Sangh.

Shri Ansar Harvani: Is the Government aware that the youth organisations in the Soviet Union and the People's Republic of China are not affiliated to this Assembly?

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: Hon. Members are asking questions which have absolutely no relevance to this question.

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: They are giving information.

Shri Pannoose: May I know the total membership of those organisations which are affiliated to this world organisation from India, and may I also know whether there are other youth organisations which are not affiliated to this?

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: I have already answered that question. I have already said there are three organisations which are affiliated to this organisation.

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: The question is whether their strength is known or not.

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: I cannot give their number or strength.

Shri Panigrah: I would like to know the nature of help that the Government of India is proposing to extend to this Convention.

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: The organisation wrote to the Government to give some assistance, but the organisation has not yet indicated the special kind of assistance it would need, and I am told most of the expenditure would be met by the organisation itself.

Shri Heda rose.—

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: Would he like himself to be included in youth?

Shri Heda: At least I am connected with some organisations.

Mr. Deputy-Speaker: All right.

Shri Heda: May I know whether the Government of India think it advisable that from the Indian point of view they should accept some organisations in India as representatives of Indian youth, and if so, whether they have accepted some organisations, and in that case, may I know the names of those organisations?

Dr. K. L. Shrimali: Government has no organisations of its own. Government wants to encourage all organisations which work on democratic lines.

India Re-insurance Corporation

*997, **Shri Heda:** Will the Minister of Finance be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have studied the working of India Re-insurance Corporation Ltd.; and

(b) whether they are satisfied with its working?

The Deputy Minister of Finance (Shri B. K. Bhagat): (a) and (b). The India Re-Insurance Corporation Limited which is a private enterprise, commenced working from the 1st January, 1957. The report of its first year of working will be available only sometime about the middle of 1958.
