Kalinga Airlines

Will the Minister of Transport and Communications be pleased to refer to the reply given to Starred Question No. 565 on the 3rd December, 1959 an dstate:

(a) whether Government have since examined the Accident Investigation Report regarding the crash of an aircraft of Kalinga Airlines on the 3rd August, 1959; and

(b) if so, the result thereof?

The Deputy Minister of Civil Aviation (Shri Mohiaddin): (a) and (b). The report has been examined. In the opinion of the Government certain findings in the report called for further investigation and an Expert Departmental Committee was appointed for the purpose. The Committee has since submitted its report which is under examination.

Aerodrome at Forloshganj (Bihar)

Will the Minister of Transport and Communications be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Central Government have decided to construct an aerodrome at Forloshganj (Bihar);

(b) if so, the progress so far made and the expenditure incurred up till now; and

(c) how much time it will require to complete?

The Deputy Minister of Civil Aviation (Shri Mohiaddin): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) and (c). The lands originally required had since been acquired. The earth-work had also made reasonable progress. But the work had to be suspended as it was found that there were some graves in this area. In order to exclude the graves, the Government have decided to realign the runway by acquiring another 34 acres of extra land. As soon as it becomes known that no graves/mosque fall in these 34 acres and these lands become available the work will be completed in 18 months. Upto 29th February, 1960 an expenditure of Rs. 1.19 lakhs approximately had been incurred on this project.
