**National Discipline Schemes in Basic Schools**

\*870. Shri Bibhuti Mishra: Will the Minister of Education and Scientific Research be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Government are contemplating to give increased financial assistance for the introduction of National Discipline Scheme in Basic Schools of States and Union Territories,

(b) if so, the nature of the proposal; and

(c) the period within which it will be implemented?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research (Dr. K. L. Shrimall): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. The National Discipline Scheme is already in force in a number of schools in the colonies of displaced persons in certain States. It is now proposed to extend it to a large number of schools, in areas other than displaced persons' colonies, in three regions in Punjab, Bombay and West Bengal. The Scheme will cover basic schools also. The details of the scheme and the financial implications are still under examination. It is hoped to implement the scheme on this larger scale from this year.
