Title: Regarding delay in sanctioning posts for Aligarh Muslim University Centre, Kishanganj-laid.

DR. MOHAMMAD JAWED (KISHANGANJ): Aligarh Muslim University Centre, Kishanganj was established by the Government of India in the year 2013 in view of the shortage of educational institutions in Seemanchal region. The objective of the centre is to provide higher educational facilities to the students of Kishanganj and its adjoining districts.

In the year 2014, UPA government had allocated an amount of Rs. 136.82 crores during XII plans for establishment of Kishanganj Centre for students of Bihar against which only an amount of Rs. 10 crores have been released.

Delay in sanctioning staff is acting as an impediment for the teachers to fulfil their assigned duties and hindering the intended educational activities of the institution. I humbly request you to kindly sanction the posts of teaching and non-teaching staff for AMU Centre, Kishanganj.
