Title: Regarding better road connectivity between districts of West Bengal and Garo Hills -laid.

DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR (BALURGHAT): The road connection needs to be re-established between Hili-Balurghat of West Bengal and Mahendraganj-Tura in Meghalaya passing through Bangladesh. This will reduce distance between Hili–Balurghat and Mahendraganj-Tura, save time and money, boost the economy of the two states, facilitate cultural exchanges, and above all, benefit farmers and business community and students of the two States.
