Title: Regarding setting up of harbour and fishing jellies on Gandak river in Bihar-laid.

SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY (SARAN): The fish production in Bihar was estimated at 602.13 thousand tonnes in 2018-19. This quantum of produce is comparable to states that have an existing fishing harbour or a proposal for a new harbour- Maharashtra, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Odisha, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh. However, there is no fishing harbour in the vicinity of Patna and North Bihar at the moment.

The district of Saran lies at the confluence of the Ganga, Gandak and Ghaggar. The river Son also joins the Ganga just south of Saran at Maner Sharif in Patna. I request that a harbour and fishing jellies be set up on the river Gandak at Maker near Rewa Bridge on NH-722, at Kali Ghat on the confluence of the rivers Ganga and Gandak in Sonepur and at Ami in Dighwara near NH-19.
