Title: Regarding establishment of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Perambalur Parliamentary Constituency-laid.

DR. T. R. PAARIVENDHAR (PERAMBALUR): My Perambalur parliamentary constituency is one of the under developed constituencies in Tamil Nadu. It is also an agriculture based constituency and around 70% of the people are farmers. This Perambalur parliamentary constituency has 06 Assembly constituencies, in which Perambalur Assembly constituency is the district Headquarter. It has a Kendriya Vidyalaya. In other remaining five assembly constituencies, there are no big government schools. So, many parents of my Parliamentary Constituency are forced to put their children in private schools.

So, I urge upon the Hon'ble Minister of Education to take an early action to establish a new Kendriya Vidyalaya at Lalgudi (Tiruchirappalli District) and Kullthalai (Karur District) Assembly constituencies which are located in my Perambalur Parliamentary Constituency.
