Title : Regarding problems being faced by residents residing in Leh and Kargil districts of Ladakh –laid.

SHRI JAMYANG TSERING NAMGYAL (LADAKH): It is unfortunate that the families residing in Lato, Hunderman, Thang, Teakshi, Turtuk and other villages and hamlets of Leh and Kargil districts of Union Territory of Ladakh region due to the ceasefire in 1947-48 and Indo-Pak war in 1971, have been divided because of the border division between India and Pakistan Occupied Ladakh; due to which the members of the same family are staying away from each other across the border.
