Title: Regarding opening of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Nagar Kurnool Parliamentary Constituency, Telangana.

SHRI RAMULU POTHUGANTI (NAGARKURNOOL): Sir, I thank you for giving me an opportunity to raise an important issue during Zero Hour regarding opening of Kendriya Vidyalayas in my Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency.

Nagarkurnool is one of the very backward regions in the country. The newly created districts, namely, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal and Waranparthy fall under my Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency. The literacy rate of this place is very low. In this context, I am constrained to bring to the kind notice of the Union Minister for Human Resource Development that not a single Kendriya Vidyalaya School or any other educational institution has been established there till now. As a result of this, students of this region are forced to study in private schools which are very expensive for the poor parents of this region as most of them are farmers, workers, labourers, etc. So, opening of one Kendriya Vidyalaya School in each district of Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal and Waranparthy is the need of the hour.

Keeping in view the present position, I would, therefore, earnestly request the Union Minister for HRD that one Kendriya Vidyalaya each at the newly created districts, Nagarkurnool, Jogulamba Gadwal and Waranparthy in my Nagarkurnool Parliamentary Constituency may kindly be sanctioned in the interest of the students.
