(b) if so, whether any steps are being taken to counteract the same?

The Minister of Information and Broadcasting (Dr. Keskar): (a) No, Sir, not to our knowledge.

(b) Does not arise.

Shri K. Subrahmanyam: Is the Government's information based on investigation?

Dr. Keskar: Yes, Sir.

# GOVERNMENT HOUSING FACTORY

\*463. Shri A. K. Gopalan: Will the Minister of Production be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government propose to place a report of the working of the Government Housing Factory, with figures regarding the total money invested in it, the losses incurred, etc.; and
- (b) who were responsible for the losses, if any, incurred to the State's finance with regard to the Housing Factory and what action, if any, was taken in the matter?
- The Minister of Production (Shri K. C. Reddy): (a) A short report of the working of the Factory with a statement of expenditure incurred on the factory upto 30th April 1952 is placed on the Table of the House [See Appendix III, annexure No. 14.]
- (b) The fact of an absolute loss has not yet been established definitely, as utilising the Factory for the production of pre-fabricated houses of a type different from the one originally contemplated is under the active consideration of Government.
- Shri A. K. Gopalan: What were the terms of the contract with Messrs. Engineers of India, and when they failed to fulfil their contract, what steps were taken against them?
- Shri K. C. Reddy: I cannot go into all the details, but necessary steps have been taken in this behalf; it is too early to say as to what final steps will be taken by the Government.
- Shri A. K. Gopalan: Was any compensation demanded from them?
- Shri K. C. Reddy: I should like to have notice to give further details in this regard.
  - Shri A. K. Gopalan: May I know if any further advances have been made to the Indo-Swedish firm by the Government of India?

Shri K. C. Reddy: No. Sir.

- Shri A. M. Gopalan: What is the meaning of "the fact of an absolute loss has not yet been established definitely"?
- Shri K. C. Reddy: The anticipated loss, as the statement shows, is about Rs. 19 lakhs, but we cannot at this stage declare that it is an absolute loss, as we have got proposals to utilise this factory for different purposes. And what may be considered to be a loss now might not turn out to be a loss utilimately.

#### Khadi PRODUCTION

[\*464. Shri R. S. Tiwarl: Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government have prepared or are considering any scheme for increasing the production of Khadi;
- (b) whether Government issued orders to other Ministries last year regarding the increasing use of Khadi;
- (c) if so, whether there has been any increase in the use of Khadi; and
- (d) if so, what is the quantum of such increase?]

The Deputy Minister of Commerce and Industry (Shri Karmarkar):

(a) Certain State Governments have initiated schemes for development of thadi. The Central Government's interest in khadi development is

dovetailed with schemes for the development of Cottage Industries and handicrafts and in this connection, the Central Government are examining various proposals for the encouragement and the consequent increase in the production of khadi.

- (b) No, Sir.
- (c) and (d). Do not arise.

In addition to the written reply I gave to part (a), I should also state that during 1951-52 we made a token grant of Rs. 2 lakhs for the development of khadi and placed it at the disposal of the khadi organisations.

श्री आर॰ एस॰ तिवारी: इस के अनुसार सरकार ने कितना खर्च किया है ?

[Shri B. S. Tiwari: How much have the Government spent on it accordingly?]

श्री करनेरकर: में ने अभी कहा कि गये वर्ष में दो लाख रुपया अखिल भारतीय चर्चा संघ के डिस्पोसल पर रखा था ताकि खादी को प्रोत्साहन मिले।

[Shri Karmarkar: I have just now stated that a sum of rupees two lakhs was kept at the disposal of the All India Spinners' Association for encouraging Khadi.

श्री आर॰ एस॰ तिवारी: क्या सरकार ने इस योजना के अन्तर्गत स्वयं खादी की खरीद की है ?

[Shri R. S. Tiwari: Have the Government themselves purchased any ranaai under this plan?]

श्रीं करमरकर ! में जानता हूं कि टैक्स-टाइल कमिश्नर के मार्फ़त कुछ खरीदी गई है। ये फ़ीगर्स हैं:

[Shri Karmarkar: I am told that some Khadi has been purchased through the Textile Commissioner. These are the figures:]

In 1950-51 khadi worth Rs. 60,277.

In 1951-52 khadi worth Rs. 67.287.

I understand further that the Railway Ministry have also issued

instructions to all railways to accept hadi as far as possible to meet their requirements of cloth.

श्री एस॰ एन॰ दास: क्या सरकार के घ्यान में यह बात लाई गई है कि खादी ना उत्पादन बहुत बढ़ गया है और बिकी कम होती है इस वजह से काम में बाघा पड़नें वाली है ?

[Shri S. N. Das: Has it been brought to the notice of the Government that the production of khadi has increased tremendously and the demand for it has fallen which may prove detrimental to the interests of the industry?]

श्री करमरकर: समझा नहीं।

[Shri Karmarkar: I have not followed.]

श्री एस॰ एन॰ दास: मेरा यह मतलब है कि क्या सरकार को मालूम है कि खादी का उत्पादन बहुत हो जाने के कारण से और उस की खपत या बिकी कम होने से खादी के काम में बाधा पड़ती है ?

[Shri S. N. Das: What I mean say is whether the Government are aware of the fact that the cause of what suffers by its increasing production and decreasing demand.]

श्री करमरकर: सरकार यह जानती है कि खादी की पैदाबार ज्यादा होने लगी है और उस की खपत कम है। इस बारे में सरकार जो कर सकती है वह करने की कोशिश करेगी।

[Shri Karmarkar: The Government are alive to the situation that the increased while the demand for it has fallen. They would try to do whatever they possibly can in this connection.]

श्री एस० एन० वास: क्या में जान सकता हू कि केन्द्रीय सरकार इस बात के लिये विचार रखती है कि जो उस के अपने काम हैं उस में सादी का इस्तेमाल किया जाय? [Shri S. N. Das: May I know whether the Central Government are contemplating the use of Khadi for their own purposes?]

Mr. Speaker: It is more or less a suggestion for action—he wants that Government should purchase khadi for their purposes.

Shri Karmarkar: Only a few months have passed since this amount was actually given.

भी जांगड़े: क्या मंत्री महोदय बतलाने की कुपा करेंगे कि अखिल भारतीय चर्खा बोघ को कई लेने में सरकार ने कोई सहूलियत नहीं दी जिस के कारण गत वर्ष खादी उत्पा-दन में बहुत कमी हुई ?

[Shri Jangde: Will the hon. Minister please state whether it is a fact that the Government did not give any facilities to the All India Spinners' Association in the matter of the purchase of cotton, with the result that there was a substantive decrease in the of Knadi?]

Shri Karmarkar: No, Sir. I repudiate that suggestion. In fact, where there was any complaint from any khadi-producing centre about relief in respect of transport of cotton we were very heartly helping them.

Mr. Speaker: That very question was put earlier and I overruled it as being a suggestion for action—this one is also an argument.
