SCHEDULED CASTES AND SCHEDULED TRIBES

*772. **Shri B. N. Kureel:** Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state whether Government have decided to open centres for imparting technical training to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, on the lines on which a Centre of this nature is being run by the Uttar Pradesh Government?

The Deputy Minister of Home Affairs (Shri Datar): The matter is primarily for the State Governments to consider. The Government of India make grants-in-aid for the implementation of selected schemes drawn up by the State Governments to promote the welfare of the Scheduled Tribes and development of Scheduled Areas and to achieve the effective removal of untouchability.

श्री बी० एन० कुरील: टैक्निकल ट्रेनिंग के लिए कहां कहां सेंटर खोले जाने वाले हैं?

Shri Datar: So far as the training is concerned, my information is that there is no such institute for Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes in Uttar Pradesh. So far as some other States are concerned, there are technical institutes in Bihar, Bombay, Hyderabad, Rajasthan and Ajmer.

Shri Thimmaiah: May I know whether the Government proposes to suggest to the Planning Commission to open industrial training schools for the benefit of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes under the second Five Year Plan so that they may be trained and absorbed in the various industries that you are going to start in future?

Shri Datar: Such suggestions are already before the State Governments and the Planning Commission does not execute such schemes at all.

Shri Velayudhan: May I know whether it is the policy of the Government to start separate training institutions like this for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes?

Shri Datar: Generally, the policy is not to start separate schools unless where the opening of such schools is absolutely essential in the interests of the Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes.

Shri B. S. Murthy: What are the States in which special technical training is imparted to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes?

Shri Datar: I have not got the details here; but I can say that there is the Chaibassa Technical School in Bihar, the Teachers' Training School in Hyderabad and an Industrial Training Camp in Rajasthan.
