and or Local Board authorities. No final decision has so far been reached with regard to the construction of any of these road over-bridges.

(c) This can be taken in hand only after the Punjab Government allot funds for covering their share of the cost of this overbridge.

Of this loss at least 75% is estimated to be due to drought.
