content of the letter, the hon. Member is ying to get confirmation from me to which I will not be in a position to say either yes or no. The recommendations along with the memorandum of action taken will have to be laid on the Table of the House within six months. That is the outer limit that has been prescribed. I must compliment the Commission that it has submitted its report in a record time. It did not delay matters at all but the delay was because of the fact that the conspiracy aspect was to be included in the terms of reference and the Judge himself said that he cannot possibly agree for the conspiracy to be included in the terms of reference. It took almost three to three and a half months. That was the only delay. Otherwise, I must pay compliments to the Commission that it has submitted its report well in time.

SHRI CHANDRA JEET YADAV: Sir, I did not get my answer. I said that they have appointed a high-powered Committee and I wanted to know as to who is heading that Committee and whether any time limit has been given to that Committee to give its recommendations so that follow up action can be taken.

SHRI S.B. CHAVAN: Sir, there are certain recommendations where future action has to be taken so far as the security aspect is concerned. The Committee is headed by the Cabinet Secretary, and Home Secretary. Law Secretary and the Director (IB) are its members. They are supposed to submit their report within three months.

SHRI ATAL BIHARI VAJPAYEE: Is it a fact that there are too many intelligence agencies? Is it also a fact that there is no coordination between the intelligence agencies of the Central Government and the state Government? Even at the central level there are two or three intelligence agencies. Is it not a fact that the Commission has pointed out this fact? I would like to know whether the Government is going to take some action on this to see that there will be coordination.

SHRI S.B. CHAVAN: Agencies are there, there is no doubt about it. There is a State agency. At the central level also we have the Director I.B., we have R.A.W. and on the Revenue Side the Finance Ministry is also there. These different agencies do coordinate. But I cannot possibly say that there is no scope for improvement.

- (b) The following are some of the steps undertaken by Govt. of India to encourage such researches in future.
 - (i) Continuation of production and improvement of already developed immunodiagnostice/vaccines with a view to reduce cost, dose, packing/transport, schedule and diagnostics tests/vaccines.

Water Crisis in Delhi

SHRI RAM NARESH SINGH: *.30 SHRIJEEWAN SHARMA:

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVEL-OPMENT (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) It is reported by Delhi Water supply & Sewage Disposal Undertaking that mainly areas situated at the tail end of the distribution line and those located at higher levels were affected for about two months. However, the breach in western Yamuna Canal caused acute scarcity of drinking water in west Delhi and parts of North Delhi from 14th June to 20th June.
 - (c) The reasons are reported to be:
 - (i) Non-availability of raw water and low regeneration in river Yamuna.
 - (ii) Closure of Bhakra Canal for repairs.
 - (iii) Breach in the Western Yamuna

- (d) The requirement of drinking water in Delhi @ 50 gallons per capita per day is 625 MGD at the production point. The Delhi water Supply & Sewage Disposal Undertaking is equipped to supply 472 MGD but by maximising production it has been able to supply 500MGD on an average.
- (e) The Delhi Water Supply & Sewage Disposal Undertaking has reported that following steps have been or being taken to meet the shortage and rationalise supply of water:
 - (i) rationalise distribution of water in different areas:
 - (2) construction of additional reservoirs and booster pumping stations in different areas;
 - (3) construction of additional treatment plants;
 - (4) augmenting availability of raw water from neighbouring States.

Barauni Refinery

*32. SHRI SURYA NARAYAN SINGH: Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI B. SHANKAR-ANAND): (a) to (c). Barauni Refinery has a capacity of 3.3 million tonnes per annum. There has been an unutilised refining capacity because of short supply of crude oil from North-East. Since the entire crude produced in North-East has been processed, the question of loss on account of this does not arise.

(d) and (e). Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., has submitted a proposal for laying a new crude pipeline from Haldia to Barauni for an enitail capacity of 1.8 MMTPA at an esti-

mated cost of Rs. 443.79 crores.

Foodgrains Production

*33. SHRI HARI KEWAL PRASAD: SHRI BRIJBHUSHAN SHARAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total quantity of foodgrains produced in the country during the 1991-92 Rabi season. State-wise;
- (b) whether the production of foodgrains falls short of its requirement;
- (c) if so, the extent thereof and reasons therefor; and
- (d) the measures proposed to be taken by the Government to meet the requirement?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI BALRAM JAKHAR): (a) The final estimates of production of foodgrains during 1991-92 rabi season have not yet been received from the States. However, according to the available information the production of Rabi foodgrains during 1991-92 is expected to be around 75 million tonnes. A Statement giving Statewise break up of the likely production of Rabi foodgrains is attached.

(b) and (c). The requirement of

foodgrains at a given point of time depends upon a number of factors like population; production and availability; income level and distribution; level of process; availability and prices of substitutes, etc. As such, it is difficult to assess the requirement and shortfall of foodgrains. However, the per capita availability of foodgrains during 1992 is estimated to be about 175 Kgs. Which is the highest since 1984 except for the year 1989 and 1991.

The main reason for pressure on demand of foodgrains during the current year is smootfall in production of coarse cereals in kharit season 1991-92.

(d) Besides, undertaking various measures for increasing production, the Government has already contracted for import of 1.005 million tonnes of wheat with a view to increasing the availability and to contain the open market prices of foodgrains.






