Preliminary steps for implementation of the project such as land acquisition etc. are in hand. Details of the project are being worked out. Fullfledged implementation of the project is likely to go beyond 1995-96.

Late Running of Trains

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SURESH KALMADI) : (a) and (b). No, Sir. However, at times trains do run late due to reasons such as accidents, agitations, bad weather, equipment failures, alarm-chain pulling, miscreant activities etc.

(c) to (e). The work of patch doubling between Ghaziabad and Moradabad (37 kms.) line has been included in the Budget 1995-96 at a cost of Rs. 30 crores with an outlay of Rs. 5 crores for 1995-96. The work on this line is proposed to be taken up under BOLT Scheme. The target date for completion of this work is 1997-98.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTRONICS AND OCEAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI EDUARDO FALEIRO) : (a) The Central Government outlay for development of electronics during the current year and the VIII Plan is as follows :

(b) There is no specific allocation of Central Outlay Statewise in the Electronics Sector. The Department of Electronics allocates from the Central Outlay. Its resources on various projects/programmes depending upon the requirement of the Electronics Industry which is decided by various expert Councils and Committees. Such Projects and Programmes are in the nature of infrastructure setting up or sponsored projects for specific technology development or manpower development.

(c) The details of the various projects/programmes supported by the Department of Electronics so far in Gujarat during the VIIIth Plan are given in the enclosed *Statement*.

(d) During the period 1992—95, 7 proposals involving foreign direct investment were approved for electronic units in the State of Gujarat for the manufacture of blank video cassette, PC Board, Compact Disc and Compact Disc Drives and Software Development under Electronics Hardware Technology Park (EHTP) and Software Technology Park (STP) Schemes as well as the domestic sector and 100% Export Oriented Unit (EOU) Scheme.
