Increase in Air India Flights

THE MINISTER OF CIVIL AVIAITON AND TOURISM (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCIN-DIA): (a) and (b). In order to promote tourism, the number of flights of Air India have recently (with effect from 27.10.1991) been increased from 7 per week to 10 per week on the India-Singapore route and from 4 per week to 6 per week on India-Japan route.
