**The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla):** (a) No such proposals have been received from the State Governments.

#### **I.C.S. Officers on Deputation**

**\*1066. Shri Harish Chandra Mathur:** Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the number of officers out of the twenty-five senior-most I.C.S. Officers who continue to be on deputation with Central Government for four years;

(b) the number of other All India Officers who are on deputation for over four years; and

(c) the reasons for stay beyond tenure period?

**The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Home Affairs (Shri L. N. Mishra):** (a) 13.

(b) IAS—166.

IPS—75.

(c) In public interest. All the above officers, however, are not overstaying their tenure which is five years for Police jobs and also in posts of Joint Secretary and equivalent.

#### **Hindi Writers of Non-Hindi-Speaking Areas**

**\*1067. Shri Yashpal Singh:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is proposed to award prizes to Hindi writers of non-Hindi-speaking areas;

(b) if so, the broad outlines of the scheme; and

(c) when the scheme is likely to be launched?

**The Deputy Minister in the Ministry of Education (Shri Bhakt Darshan):** (a) Yes, Sir.

(c) The scheme has already been launched. To begin with prizes will be awarded on 'Fiction' and entries have been invited from the intending competitors by 30th June, 1964 through a Press Note.

#### **Expenditure incurred on Research in Universities**

**2162. Shri Sidheshwar Prasad:** Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

(a) the percentage of the total departmental expenditure incurred on research in the four Central Universities from 1950-51 to 1962-63; and

(b) the percentage of the university staff taken respectively for teaching and research during that period?

**The Minister of Education (Shri M. C. Chagla):** (a) and (b). It is not possible to indicate exactly the percentage of expenditure on research as the teaching and research go together and no separate allocations are made for the purposes. However, it is presumed that roughly 20 per cent of the total expenditure relates to research in Science Departments and 10 per cent in Humanities and Engineering and Technology Departments.

Similarly, it is not possible to indicate the proportion of staff conducting teaching and research respectively as no teacher is exclusively appointed either for teaching or for research work. All teachers are expected to participate in the teaching and research activities of the department.
