Wild Animals in National Parks

3740. Shri Nitiraj Singh Chaudhary: Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) the types and number of wild animals in 1960 and now in various National Parks separately for each period;

(b) whether there is a reduction in their number now and if so, the causes thereof and the steps taken to stop this decline; and

(c) by what time the results should be expected?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Annasahib Shinde): (a) to (c). The information is being collected and will be placed on the Table of the Sabha in due course.

Development of Horticulture in M.P.

3741. Shri Nitiraj Singh Chaudhary: Shri G. S. Mishra:

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state the amount proposed to be given to the Madhya Pradesh Government for development of horticulture during 1967-68?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Annasahib Shinde): The Central financial assistance is not sanctioned or released for individual schemes but only for broad heads of development. As such it is not possible to give the figures of Central assistance intended exclusively for development of horticulture in Madhya Pradesh during 1967-68.

Supply of Fertilizer to Madhya Pradesh

3742. Shri Nitiraj Singh Chaudhary: Shri G. S. Mishra:

Will the Minister of Food and Agriculture be pleased to state:

(a) the quantity of Fertilizers supplied to Madhya Pradesh during 1965-66 and 1966-67;

(b) whether this quota will be increased; in 1967-68; and

(c) if so, the quantity thereof?

The Minister of State in the Ministry of Food, Agriculture, Community Development and Cooperation (Shri Annasahib Shinde): (a) The different kinds of Nitrogenous fertilizers supplied to Madhya Pradesh during the years 1965-66, and 1966-67 are as follows:

N.B.—The State Government had a carry-over stock of 36,232 tonnes of Nitrogen on 1-4-66. Hence they surrendered allotments other than the quantity allotted during the 1st quarter of 1966-67.

(b) and (c). The State Government had a carry-over stock of 17,300 tonnes Nitrogen on 1st April, 1967. Taking this and the different production programmes of the State into consideration it is proposed to allot 12,000 tonnes Nitrogen to Madhya Pradesh during 1967-68, to meet its fertiliser requirements.
