Tata Chemicals Limited, M/s Century Chemicals Limited, and M/s Ballarpur Industries Limited, who are having their own captive salt works in Gujarat have been permitted domestic sale of salt in limited quantities both for edible and industrial purposes.

- (d) Does not arise.

Linking of Bhubneswar by Air

- (b) and (c). Due to severe capacity constraints, there are at present no plans to airlink more places with Bhubaneswar.

- (b) There are 39 proposals for opening of new retail outlets (Petrol/Diesel) in Karnataka. But in view of the various steps preceding the actual commissioning of the retail outlets, it is not possible to indicate how many of these would be opened during the current year.
- (c) and (d). In order to meet the growing demand, the oil industry carries out periodical surveys and locations satisfying the norms are included in the Oil Industry's Annual Marketing Plan, subject to overall product availability.
