

**Re: Setting up of Trauma Care Centres in Anakapalle Parliamentary Constituency ? laid**

**DR. BEESETTI VENKATA SATYAVATHI (ANAKAPALLE):** The National Highways Authority of India and the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways are making concerted efforts to conduct additional road safety audits and eliminate black spots or areas with a high occurrence of fatal road accidents. Based on NCRB data, around 5 lakh road accidents occur in India each year, causing approximately 1.5 lakh fatalities. Within Andhra Pradesh, there are roughly 25,000 road accidents annually, resulting in over 12,000 deaths and numerous serious injuries. Statistics shows that eighteen people die every hour in road accidents in the country. Road accidents in various cities, states and towns are continuously increasing in the country. I would like to bring to the notice of the Government that we have two black spots in my Parliamentary Constituency Thotada junction and Purshotapuram. Hence, I request Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport and Highways and Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family Welfare to sanction Trauma Care Centers, one for district hospital Anakapalli and one for CHC Nakkapalli in my Anakapalle Parliamentary Constituency, Andhra Pradesh.
