

Need to construct granite stone barrier along the coast to protect the villagers of Puducherry and Karaikal - laid

SHRI VE. VAITHILINGAM (PUDUCHERRY): The sea erosion along the coastal areas of Puducherry and Karaikal regions has become a regular phenomenon for the last few decades. Sea wall and Groins are constructed along the White Town area for about two kilometers over a period of time to protect the urban habitations. The coastal villages are affected very badly due to the sea erosion. The local government doing some anti sea erosion works here and there without proper planning and study leading to avoidable expenditure. Recently, sea water entered into the fishermen dwellings along the coast. Urgent comprehensive planning is required to protect the coastal regions of Puducherry and Karaikal. I request the Union Government to assess the situation and take immediate action for protection of the coastal villages. I request to make a detailed study and construct granite stone barrier along the coast of these coastal villages to save the lives of fishermen and their houses.
