Regarding recent incident of violence in Manipur-laid

Manipur reported 142 deaths in June 2023 and no signs of reduction could be seen in July. With destruction of property and 54,000 displacements, the situation is grim. In the land of Mary Kom, violence against women has reached alarming levels. The state faces headlines of women being shot and raped in particular. A video on social media has caused immediate Government intervention to prevent its spread and yet, it took authorities 77 days for arrests in the case. I seek clarification from the Government on measures being taken to resolve this conflict. I urge them to formulate a plan to safeguard women in conflict zones and involve them in peacebuilding. Let's not forget Manipur's legacy of fearless women. It's our responsibility to stand up for them. Beti bachegi, tabhi toh padhegi.
