

Regarding stoppage of trains at Kallidaikurichi Railway Station in Tamil Nadu - laid

SHRI S. GNANATHIRAVIAM (TIRUNELVELI): More than 30 thousand people live in Kallidaikurichi town in my Tirunelveli constituency. Those who are living in the surrounding areas make use of Kallidaikurichi station for connectivity and commuting to neighbouring districts. Tamil Nadu Police Training Centre, 9th Reserve Police Battalion, Students, Office goers, Traders and others use this Kallidaikurichi station for commuting to different places. Several tourist places like Manimuthaaru falls, Maancholai Estate are also situated here thereby attracting thousands of tourists. Kallidaikurichi railway station is being used by maximum number of rail commuters generating much revenue next to Ambasamudram in the Tirunelveli-Shenkottairail route. In the Madurai Railway division, Kallidaikurichi station stands at No 44 in revenue generation and at No 27 in the usage by maximum number of rail commuters. I urge upon the Hon'ble Minister of Railways that all the trains including Passenger, Express and Superfast trains should have a stoppage at Kallidaikurichi benefitting the people at large.
