Setting up of T.V. Transmission Centre In Remote Border Areas of Uttar Pradesh

273. SHRI M. S. PAL: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether any scheme to set up Doordarshan Transmission Centres in remote border areas is under consideration of the Government;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government also propose to set up Doordarshan Transmission Centre in Kumaon division of Uttar Pradesh;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) and (b). Whereas schemes for the establishment of ten high power TV transmitters, one each at Barmer, Rameshwaram, Jaisalmer, Bhuj, Fazilka, Mokokchung, Churachandpur, Lunglei, Leh and Gangtok; and six very low power (2x10 W) TV transmitters, one each at Kilhotran, Sankoo, Dras, Timsogam, Phek and Munsiri are already under implementation in the border and remote areas of the country, any further expansion of Doordarshan network in such areas would

depend upon the availability of adequate financial resources for the purpose.

(c) to (e). Yes, Sir. A very low power (2x10 W) TV transmitter is under establishment at Munsiri in Kumaon division of Uttar Pradesh.

Installation of Low Power Transmitters In Gujarat

274. SHRI KASHIRAM RANA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government of Gujarat have submitted any proposal to the Union Government for setting up of more 51 low power transmitters to cover remaining areas of the State for T.V. Transmission; and

(b) if so, the action taken by the Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI SUBODH KANT SAHAY): (a) Yes, Sir. A proposal to this effect was received some time back.

(b) It is the constant endeavour of the Government to extend TV service to the uncovered parts of the country, as expeditiously as possible. This can, however, be undertaken only in a phased manner depending upon the availability of resources for the purpose.
