Recruitment of Constables/Riflemen except in NSG is made on an all India basis. The annual vacancies are allotted to each State/Union Territory on the basis of population ratio and recruitment to these vacancies are made in a phased manner from various places after giving wide publicity. Candidates who possess the prescribed eligibility conditions can appear for selection at the notified centres. This procedure ensures fair representation of each State/Union Territory in the Forces according to its population ratio.

Appointments in NSG is made by transfer on deputation only.
