Proposals have been received from the Administration for creation of some additional posts in the Pradesh Council Secretariat.

(d) A work study of the Pradesh Council Secretariat is to be conducted. Further action will be considered in the light of the Work Study report.

Utilisation of sea weeds

- 4472. SHRI ANANTA PRASAD SETHI: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:
- (a) whether Government have appointed any Committee of Experts to explore the ways and means for utilisation of sea weeds in the manufacture of food articles. Fertilizers, certain Chemicals and pharmaceutical;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) steps taken to standardize the technology of mass culture of seaweeds?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECH-NOLOGY AND IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, ATOMIC ENERGY, SPACE AND ELECTRONICS (SHRI SHIVRAJ V. PATIL): (a) A Committee of Scientists of CSIR was constituted by the Director-General, CSIR on the area of Sea-weeds.

- (b) The report prepared by the Committee has outlined R&D programmes on sea-weed cultivation, chemistry and utilisation.
- (c) Research work has led to knowhow for cultivation of red algae variety suitable for production of Agar-agar, and Sargassum variety for production of Alginic acid for use in food, textile & cosmetic industries.

Losses in ITDC Hotels in the capital

- 4473. SHRI SANAT KUMAR MAN-DAL: Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :
- (a) the cumulative losses sustained by the various Hotels run by the India Tourism Development Corporation in the capital, as per latest information available with his Ministry or the ITDC:
- (b) the reasons for these heavy losses, when hotels in private sector in the capital are prospering;
- (c) whether some of these Hotels including 5 Starred ones have recently let out their chunk of rooms to the private companies for setting up their Offices:
- (d) if so, the number of rooms let out by each one of these hotels; at what rate, the room discount given; the period for which let out and the advance rent, if any received and the name of the company concerned; and
- (e) whether the reaction of the elitist clientele of these 5 Starred hotels to such room use has been assessed; if so, what?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a) and (b). Nine hotels being operated by ITDC in the capital have earned overall net profit of Rs. 18.44 crores upto the financial year 1984-85.
