Though the Directorate of Education, Delhi Administration issued instructions to all Aided Schools in 1983 to adhere to the instructions issued by the Government of India for reservation of posts for SC/ST Candidates, these could be meaningfully enforced in July, 1986, when the Management of Aided Schools were allowed to fill up vacant posts in relaxation of ban orders. Since then, out of 150 cases for appointments approved by the Director of Education, 20 cases relate to SC/ST candidates. Since the Director of Education, Delhi Administration approves appointment of teachers in Aided Schools,

he ensures compliance with the provision for reservation for SC/STs.
