

(c) A number of steps have been taken to improve the performance of the existing equipment. These include improvements in the ash evacuation system, rapping mechanism of the Precipitators, cyclones of the mechanical dust collectors. Linking-coal with reduced ash content to the power station is also being pursued. An expert Group was also set up to recommend measures to reduce pollution. The Group has, in its report recommended:—

(a) provision of a new electrostatic precipitator in place of the mechanical dust collector for Unit I;

(b) replacement of the existing electrostatic precipitators in other units by new precipitators of suitable design;

(c) regulatory orders to provide for local of 20—25 per cent ash content being supplied to Indraprastha Power Station;

(d) Research and Development measures to be initiated to collect data on the behaviour of a full-scale precipitator with low sulphur Indian coals, to study the effect of gas conditioning on the performance of precipitators and to study the optimum settings of precipitator control equipment and improved operating procedures for the same.

The recommendations of the Expert Group are under implementation by Delhi Electric Suplpy Undertaking.

**बेरोजगारी समाप्त करने के लिए योजनायें**

**प्रधानमंत्री (श्री मोरारजी देसाई) :**

(क) से (ग) योजना आयोग से यह कहा गया है कि वह रोजगार को बहुत अधिक प्रधानता देते हुए छठी पंचवर्षीय योजना तैयार करे। आयोग इस संबंध में ठोस नीतियों और कार्यक्रमों को प्रस्तावित करेगा।

#### **Capacity in Ordnance and Arms Factories**

1437. SHRI SATYENDRA NARAYAN SINHA: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any surplus capacity in Ordnance and Arms factories;

(b) if so, whether Government propose to consider entering international market for small arms; and

(c) if so, facts thereof?

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) No, Sir. The capacities of Ordnance Factories producing Arms and Ammunition are at present fully booked in meeting the requirements of the three Services and para-military forces.

(b) and (c). The question of exporting small arms to friendly countries is considered on merit as and when we have surplus capacity. It would not be in the public interest to give details thereof?

**1439. SHRI K. MALLANNA:** Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether there has been any reduction in the number of Secretaries to the Government of India recently; and

(b) if so, to what extent?

**THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI CHARAN SINGH):** (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The number of Secretaries/Special Secretaries to the Government of India stands reduced by six.

**Allocation for Tribal Sub-Plan**

**1440. SHRI K. MALLANNA:** Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Central Government have earmarked some money under the Tribal sub-plan to be spent on various development works in the backward areas in the country during the current year; and

(b) if so, the projects on which this money is going to be spent for development purposes, State-wise?

**THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI CHARAN SINGH):** (a) and (b). The Central Government has earmarked a sum of Rs. 55 crores as Special Central Assistance during the current financial year for States and Union Territories having Tribal-Sub-Plans.

The amount is to be used for tribal development programmes under the Agriculture & allied sectors, Cooperation, Industry & Minerals, Transport and Communication, Social & Community Services and Welfare of Primitive Tribes.

A statement showing the allocation of the Central assistance State-wise is annexed.
