(b) The picture presented in the press report does not reflect fully the various measures taken up by the Dandakaranya Project for the rehabilitation of the settlers in the Project area. As regards irrigation three major irrigation projects namely, Potteru Satiguda and Paralkote are in hand and on their completion substantial irrigation facilities will become available to the settlers. Several minor irrigation schemes have also been taken up and completed. The Project also provides agricultural extension service to the settlers taking into consideration the local conditions of land and climate. The problem of small trader families is engaging the attention of the Project authorities. The closure of some shops at Mana is due to the shifting of families from Mana Camp to rehabilitation sites elsewhere.
