

बैलाडिला और भिलाई के स्थानीय लोगों को कारखानों में रोजगार

416. श्री अघन सिंह ठाकुर : क्या संसदीय कार्य तथा श्रम मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या बैलाडिला और भिलाई के स्थानीय लोगों को कारखानों में रोजगार देने के मामले में प्राथमिकता नहीं दी जाती है यहां तक कि उनके नाम रोजगार कार्यालयों में पंजीकृत नहीं किए गए हैं; और

(ख) यदि हां, तो क्या सरकार का विचार इस बारे में कोई कार्यवाही करने का है, ताकि स्थानीय लोगों को रोजगार मिल सके ?

संसदीय कार्य तथा श्रम मंत्री (श्री रबीन्द्र वर्मा) : (क) उन रोजगार कार्यालयों में पंजीकृत आवेदकों के नाम अधिसूचित मांगों के उत्तर में सम्प्रेषित किए जाते हैं जिनके क्षेत्राधिकार में वे साधारणतया रहते हैं, जोकि स्थानीय लोगों के हितों की रक्षा करता है और जिसकी परिभाषा अभी तैयार की जानी है । जहां तक केन्द्रीय सरकार के उपक्रमों/उद्यमों का संबंध है, ऐसे पदों की रिक्तियां जहां मूल वेतन 500 रुपए प्रतिमास से कम है, रोजगार कार्यालयों के माध्यम से ही भरी जानी आवश्यक हैं ।

(ख) पर्याप्त रोजगार अवसरों के लिए स्थानीय लोगों के हितों की रक्षा करने के लिए रोजगार कार्यालयों द्वारा भर्ती की वर्तमान नीति को यथेष्ट समझा गया है ।

Youth Parliament Competitions were held in 37 schools situated both in urban and rural areas of the Union Territory of Delhi during the year 1977. A Statement showing the names and addresses of these schools is attached.

Government have also taken up the matter with the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations at the level of Chief Ministers for in-troduction of the Youth Parliament Scheme in rural as well as urban areas of States/Union Territories.

Provision of Jobs through Employment Exchange

418. SHRI DINEN BHATTACHARYA: Will the Minister of PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND LABOUR be pleased to state:

(a) whether the number of people recruited through employment exchange has gone down during the last three years; and

(b) if so, the steps Government propose to take to increase placement through employment exchanges?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND LABOUR (SHRI RAVINDRA VARMA): (a) and (b). The number of job-seekers placed in employment through Employment Exchanges during the years 1975, 1976 and 1977 were of the order of 40.41, 49.68 and 46.16 lakhs respectively. The marginal decrease in the placements during the year 1977 may be partly due to the non-technical Class III vacancies in the Central Government Offices being filled through the Staff Selection Commission which was set up in 1975.
