SCHEDULED CASTE SCHOLARSHIPS

548. Shri K. C. Jena: Will the Minister of Education be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of applications received by the Central Scholarship Board for Post-Matric Scholarships from the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students of Orissa for the year 1954-55:
- (b) the number among them who have been awarded the stipends;
- (c) whether these stipends have been paid; and
- (d) if not, whether Government are aware that delay in paying the stipends defeats the purpose for which they are paid?

The Minister of Education and Natural Resources and Scientific Research (Maulana Azad): (a) 113.

- (b) 109 students have been selected and the remaining four are not eligible, having failed in the last annual examination. Of the select ed students, 71 whose applications were complete have been awarded scholarships. The remaining 38 students will also be awarded scholarships as soon as their applications are completed.
- (c) Whenever possible, this has been done. Since however applications were received till August 31, 1954, payment of the first half-yearly instalment to all students was not possible. All awards are expected to be completed by next month.
- (d) There is no delay in the payment of the scholarships. The heads of institutions are all the same requested at the time of the award of a scholarship not to press the selected student for payment of tuition fees and hostel charges, if any, till the payment of scholarship reaches the institution.
