(a) whether it is a fact that the Board of Editors of History of Freedom Movement has received a manuscript in Russian by a Soviet Political Research worker on the 1857 War of Independence; and

(b) the names of other books that have been received so far from other countries in this regard?

The Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Education (Dr. M. M. Das) : (a) No, Sir.

(b) As it is a very long list, it is suggested that the Hon'ble Member may contact the Honorary Secretary, Board of Editors, History of Freedom Movement in India.

However the number of books received so far is 65 excluding a number of letters, reports and copies of speeches etc.

रक्षा और राजस्व मंत्री (श्री ए० सी० गुहा) : (क) सन् १९५४ में १५६ मन १ सेर ५० तोले निषिद्ध अफीम पकड़ी गयी जिस का मूल्य लगभग ४ लाख रुपये होता है।

(ख) उपर्युक्त अवधि में जिन मामलों का पता लगा उन के सम्बन्ध में ६,७६८ व्यक्ति गिरफ्तार किये गये।

Indian Military Academy

445. **Sardar Iqbal Singh :** Will the Minister of Defence be pleased to state :

(a) the number of cadets who passed out of the Joint Services Wing of the Indian Military Academy, Dehra Dun during this year; and

(b) the number of cadets out of those referred to in part (a) above who proceeded for specialised training for (i) Army Commissioned Officers, (ii) Naval Officers' Training Establishments and (iii) Air Force?

The Minister of Defence Organisation (Shri Tyagi) : (a) and (b) The Joint Services Wing is no longer located at Dehra Dun; it was shifted to Khadakvasla in January 1955. So far one passing out parade has been held at Khadakvasla, viz. in June 1955, from which 22 Naval cadets and 30 Air Force cadets have proceeded to Naval and Air training establishments for specialised training. The course of instruction for the Army and Air Force cadets at the Joint Services Wing, Dehra Dun, was of two years duration and for Naval cadets of three years; at Khadakvasla it will be of three years for all cadets. The third year course for the Air Force has not yet started and the Air Force cadets who passed out in June, 1955 did so after two years training. The first batch of Army cadets will be passing out of the Academy Khadakvasla in June, 1956 after completing their third year course, which commenced in July, 1955.
