THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI C. P. N. SINGH): (a) and (b). The proposal to grant productivity linked bonus to civilian employees under the R&D Organisation and other organisations under the Department of Defence is under active consideration of the Government

Production of Salt in Orissa

4388. SHRI CHINTAMANI JENA: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) how many salt industries run through co-operatives, private sectors and public sectors are producing salts in the State of Orissa and their annual productions; and

(b) whether Balang Salt Producing Co-operative Society Ltd. is one of them; if so, the improvements sought by the Society and action taken to fulfil their demands?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA):

(a) In Orissa, there are 5 salt works in the Co-operative sector, 1 in public sector and 37 in private sector. The total production of salt from all these salt works was 73,000 tonnes during 1979

(b) Balang salt producing co-operative Society Ltd. is one of the Co-operatives running salt works. The main request of the Society is for renewal of lease of land for a longer duration. Land in question, however, belongs to Government of Orissa who have to take a decision in the matter.

Industries recommended by NCAER for Goa, Daman and Diu

3489. SHRIMATI SANYOGITA RANE: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state the details of industries recommended by Nation-

al Council of Applied and Economic Research for the Union Territory of Goa, Daman and Diu and the present position in regard to these recommendations?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY (SHRI CHARANJIT CHANANA): In a report entitled "Development Programmes of Goa, Daman and Diu" published in April 1970 by the NCAER had discussed about development possibilities of individual industries under the following broad groups:—

- (1) Agro-based industries,
- (2) Forest-based industries,
- (3) Livestock-based industries.
- (4) Basic metals and metal products,
- (5) Chemical and allied industries,
- (6) Miscellaneous industries.

However, implementation of the above recommendations is the concern of the Union Territory administration. In order to assist the Union Territory administration, where necessary an inter-ministerial Task Force has been constituted in 1979 in the Ministry of Industry.

Reduction in Traditional Products by National Instrument, Ltd. Calcutta

(a) whether the National Instruments Ltd. Calcutta has reduced its traditional products which have acquired much fame and huge demands in national market;

(b) if so, reasons for reduction; and

(c) if not, the reasons why the productions have been so reduced in 1979-80 in comparison to 1974-75?
