

(g) Grant of bail in heinous and sensational offences should be vigorously opposed;

(h) All out efforts should be made to promptly detect, thoroughly investigate, quickly chargesheet all cases relating to sensational crimes;

(i) Effective steps should be taken in consultation with High Courts for prompt disposal, by early trial, of cases pending in lower courts;

(j) Trial of cases of communal riots, atrocities on Harijans rape, attack on policemen, dowry deaths and kidnapping should be expeditiously completed; and

(k) Village Defence Societies should be set up in dacoity prone areas.
