Rajasthan Railway Platforms without sheds

(b) what allocations have been made for providing these two items in the Budget and the allocation earmarked for Rajasthan; and

(c) what plans and programmes have been formulated for providing these facilities at railway station in Rajasthan and by what time they will be completed?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Drinking water facilities are available at all regular stations. However these facilities are not available at some halt stations of Western Railway listed in Annexure 'A'. A list of stations without platform sheds is enclosed as Annexure 'B'.
