## BSF Jawans Kidnapped by Bangladesh Rifles

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE HOME AFFAIRS MINISTRY OF (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c). There were no cases of such kidnapping in the Assam-Bangladesh border. A BSF patrol party had inadvertently crossed into Bangladesh territory on 11th December, 1980 while being engaged in prevention of smuggling activities on Assam-Bangladesh border. On being attacked by a violent crowd, two BSF Jawans Submitted themselves for their personal safety to a Bangladesh Rifles Party which had, by them, reached the spot. Government approached the Bangladesh authorities for the return of the Jawans, and they have been returned on 9th March, 1981.
