

physical facilities by way of construction of indoor halls in NIS, procurement of equipment of international standard and obtaining of services of foreign coaches in selected disciplines are some of the steps taken in this direction.

(c) Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports have set up a Committee with its Director as Chairman and 6 senior coaches to supervise coaching camp activities. Government has also decided to set up a Committee to monitor the progress of preparation of Indian teams and competitors for the Asian Games.

Opening and Upgradation of Post Offices in Birbhum, West Bengal

4645. SHRI GADADHAR SAHA: Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) how many branch and sub post offices are being sanctioned and opened in Birbhum District West Bengal;

(b) how many proposals for opening branch post offices—departmental and extra departmental—and upgrading branch post office to sub-post offices have been made in this District in West Bengal; and

(c) whether there is a proposal for opening a branch post office at Brahmandih for the benefit of Riupur, Kalithapur Gopinathpur and Brahmandih Rural people?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI KARTIK ORAON): (a) Two branch post offices have been sanctioned and one branch post office opened in the district.

(b) Twenty proposals for opening branch post offices and one proposal for upgradation of a branch post office into Departmental sub post office are under consideration.

(c) Yes, Sir.

Eligibility for Allotment of Type 'D' Government Accommodation

4646. SHRI T. S. NEGI: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact Government officers between the pay range of Rs. 700 to 999 have also been made eligible for getting allotment of type 'D' quarters;

(b) how many applications have been received since the issuance of the orders; and

(c) when the allotment will be made to these applicants?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI BHISHMA NARAIN SINGH): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) 297 applications have been received in Delhi.

(c) Allotments are being made in order of dates of priority of eligible employees having regard to the vacancies available.

राजस्थान और गुजरात के बीच माही नदी के जल का बंटवारा

4647. श्री बिरदाराम कुलदरिया : क्या सिंचाई मंत्री यह बताने की कृपा करेंगे कि :

(क) क्या माही नदी के जल के बंटवारे के संबंध में वर्ष 1966 में किये गये समझौते के बारे में राजस्थान और गुजरात के मुख्य मंत्रियों के बीच पुनः बातचीत हुई है ; और

(ख) यदि हां, तो तत्संबंधी ब्यौरा क्या है ?

सिंचाई मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्री जियाउर्रहमान अंसारी) : (क) और (ख). गुजरात और राजस्थान के बीच माही

के जल के बटवारे से संबंधित मामले को हल करने के लिए केन्द्रीय कृषि और सिंचाई मंत्री ने 24-12-1980 को दोनों राज्यों के मुख्य मंत्रियों के साथ विचार-विमर्श किया था। इस विचार-विमर्श के दौरान यह निश्चय किया गया था कि दोनों राज्यों के दावों के जांच करने, माही नदी में जल की उपलब्ध मात्रा का पता लगाने और माही के जल के इष्टतम उपयोग के लिए संभाव्य विकास की रूपरेखा तैयार करने के लिए केन्द्रीय जल आयोग के अध्यक्ष की अध्यक्षता में एक समिति गठित की जाए जिसमें दोनों राज्यों के मुख्य इंजीनियर शामिल हों। यह भी निश्चय किया गया था कि उक्त समिति की रिपोर्ट प्राप्त हो जाने के बाद मुख्य मंत्रियों की दूसरी बैठक बुलाई जाएगी ताकि कोई परस्पर-सम्मत हल निकाला जा सके।

उपर्युक्त के अनुसरण में, राजस्थान और गुजरात की सरकारों ने हाल ही में केन्द्रीय जल आयोग के अध्यक्ष को इस मामले के बारे में अपने-अपने पक्ष विवरण भेज दिए हैं। इस मामले में आगे कार्रवाई की जा रही है।

Upgradation of Schools in Delhi

4648. SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of schools upgraded to Senior Secondary level in Science subjects by the Directorate of Education, Delhi Administration;

(b) whether the teachers for all subjects and in particular for Mechanical Drawing have been posted in the up-graded schools;

(c) whether Science laboratories have been fully equipped by 1st March, 1981 so that the students of Senior

Secondary level can do all the practicals etc. provided in the syllabus;

(d) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(e) whether Government propose to complete the prescribed syllabus and the practicals etc. for the 11th Class Science students in those schools where such facilities could not be provided?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI S. B. CHAVAN): (a) The Delhi Administration has upgraded the following number of schools:—

(b) Out of 894 sanctioned posts of P.G.Ts. in Science subjects such as Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Engineering Drawing, 849 posts were filled and 45 posts were vacant as on 1-3-1981. Of these, 7 vacant posts are of P.G.Ts. in Engineering Drawing. It has been difficult to get candidates with the requisite qualifications for appointment as P.G.Ts. in Engineering Drawing. It is now proposed by the Delhi Administration to suitably amend the Relevant Recruitment Rules in order to enable early recruitments.

(c) These are in the process of being set up. However, all essential experiments can be performed in the existing laboratories.

(d) Do not arise.

Number of SC/ST Employees Working in F.C.I.

(a) whether it is a fact that the representation of Scheduled Castes/
