

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENTS OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, ELECTRONICS AND ENVIRONMENT (SHRI C. P. N. SINGH): (a) to (d). Yes, Sir.

(e) On the recommendation of the Committee, the Government have established a Department of Environment which is operational from Nov. 1, 1980. The recommendations of the Committee for revamping the legal and administrative measures required for ensuring effective environmental protecting are under consideration in the Government.

उद्योग और भ्रम मंत्री (श्री नारायण दत्त तिवारी) : (क) अधिसूचित पिछड़े क्षेत्रों/जलों पर लागू केन्द्रीय निवेश राज सहायता योजना के अन्तर्गत अनुसूचित-जाति/अनुसूचित जनजाति उद्यमियों सहित औद्योगिक एकक स्थापित करने वाले सभी उद्यमों राजसहायता पाने के पात्र हैं। अनुसूचित जातियों के लिए लागू की गई राज्य स्तरीय विशेष उपकरण योजना औद्योगीकरण को कुछ योजनाएं उपलब्ध करा सकती है।

(ख) चूंकि योजना राज्य सरकारों को जो पहले ही राजसहायता मंजूर करती हैं प्रतिपूर्ति देने के रूप में अनुसूचित जातियों और अनुसूचित जनजातियों के उद्योग-पतियों और उद्यमियों को दी गई राजसहायता के विवरण केन्द्र सरकार द्वारा अलग से नहीं रखे जाते हैं ?

Price Rise of Tyre and Tubes

Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether in the last four years tyre manufacturers have increased prices of various types e.g. light truck tyres, heavy truck tyres, taxi tyres and animal driven vehicles' tyres 14 times while in 11 years before this period there was only one price hike;

(b) if so, the amount of increase each time of each category as sold in open market;

(c) the dates when this matter was referred to Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices and details of recommendations made by them each time separately;

(d) whether it is also a fact that in spite of Government being expressly known against price-hikes, again in September, tyre prices have been increased by about 9 per cent; and

(e) if so, effective steps being taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY AND LABOUR (SHRI NARAYAN DATT TIWARI): (a) and (b). Each automobile tyre manufacturer has a diverse range of sizes and types. They may choose to increase the prices at a point of time of their choice. A statement based on the wholesale price indices of tyres and tubes, for the period 1977—81 is attached. As per information available with the Government, the number of times, a manufacturer increased the prices in respect of a particular type during 1977—81 could be around fourteen. For the period 1966 to 1977, the number of such increases varied between four to six.

(c) This question was referred to the Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices in May, 1978. The Report of

the Bureau was sent to the Lok Sabha in the form of a fulfilment of assurance statement, arising out of a half-an-hour discussion held in the Lok Sabha on 26-4-1978. Attention is drawn to paras 2.3 and 2.4 of the summary report.

(d) There is no formal/informal control on the prices of tyres/tubes. The price increases effected in September 1981 varied between 5 to 8 per cent.

(e) The Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices have again been requested in November 1981 to examine claims of manufacturers that the price increases are warranted by increase in costs of raw materials and other unavoidable cost elements and to advise Government on appropriate steps.
