representation of Hindustan Lever for retention of foreign majority holding and state how long the action of contravention of the regulation by Hindustan Lever, subsidiary of Uni Lever, U.K., for making the third party exports without permission of the Reserve Bank of India has been under consideration of the Government and the reason thereof?

THE MINISTER  $\mathbf{OF}$ FINANCE (SHRI R. VENKATARAMAN): Reserve Bank of India sought specific instructions of Government in June The matter has been pending with Government since Inter-Ministerial consultations are necessary before taking action against any company, for violation of EERA provisions and since the Central Government decision on this company's representation for retention of 51 per cent nonresident share-holding will be an important consideration on the question whether there has been contravention of the FERA by the company on this point.

## Reservation in Allotment of Staff Quarters to SC/ST Employees in L.I.C.

3375. SHRI M. ARUNACHALAM: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is reservation in allotment of Staff Quarters to the SC/ST employees in the LIC of India; and
- (b) if so, how many staff quarters have been allotted to them and where?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI MAGANBHAI BAROT): (a) Yes, Sir. At present, of the staff quarters faling vacant during a financial year, 10 per cent are reserved for class III and class IV employees belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes.

(b) Information regarding the number of staff quarters which stood allotted to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes employees as on 31st March, 1981 is given below:—
