Number of Players Expected to Attend the Asian Games, 1982

7270. SHRI SUBHASH CHANDRA BOSE ALLURI: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of players expected to attend the Asian Games 1982; and

(b) the number and names of the countries which have made entries in respect of the Games, so far?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) The Special Organising Committee expects about five thousand players to participate in the Asian Games 1982.

(b) The Special Organising Committee for IX Asian Games 1982 has yet to issue invitations, and, therefore, it is not possible, at this stage, to indicate the number and names of the countries which would be participating in the Games.

Changing the Name of Khanpur Depot as Ambedkar Nagar Depot

(a) whether the Municipal Corporation of Delhi renamed the areas comprising Madangir, Tigri, Khanpur, Dakshanpuri and Dakshanpuri Extension as Dr. Ambedkar Nagar vide Municipal Corporation of Delhi's Resolution No. 2563/GW/(Engg. dated 26th September, 1979 (S. No. 15);

(b) whether it is a fact that D.T.C. buses being plied through these localities bear the old name instead of new name of "Dr. Ambedkar Nagar", sec-

tor-wise and representation thereto has been received from the Delhi Scheduled Castes Welfare Association (Regd.) Ambedkar Bhawan, New Delhi on 15th January, 1981 demanding immediate change of name plates of D.T.C. buses being plied on these routes together with naming of Khanpur Depot as Dr. Ambedkar Nagar Depot;

(c) if so, the action taken by the Government to honour the sentiments of millions of people; and

(d) if not, the reasons therefor?
