

Sane Committee report

7328. SHRI R. P. DAS : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state :

(a) whether V. C. Sane Committee has submitted its report to the Government; and

(b) if so, the salient features of the Report ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (KUMARI KUMUD-BEN M. JOSHI): (a) and (b) Presumably, the Hon'ble Member is referring to a sub-committee appointed by the Drugs Consultative Committee with Shri V. C. Sane, the then Commissioner, Food and Drugs Administration, Maharashtra State, Bombay as Chairman.

The salient features of the recommendations made by the Sane Committee has already been given in reply to Unstarred Question No. 3076, answered in the Lok Sabha on 10.12.81. As stated in reply to Unstarred Question No. 6453 answered on 1st April, 1982, in the Lok Sabha, the recommendations of the Drugs Technical Advisory Board are under consideration.

Vehicles Plying in Union Territories

(c) total number of additional aforesaid automobiles proposed to be brought on the road during the next three years; commensurate with demand (quote the assessed demand);

(d) the number of hired vehicles brought on road in each year (mention category) and the conditions on which they were hired; and

(e) whether temporary permits were granted to hired vehicles and whether temporary residents of Delhi or of adjoining areas are debarred from applying for such permits?
