and technologists. Under this programme, steps are being taken to fill up all vacant posts in science and technology in governmental, non-governtal and public sector undertakings; a National S&T Intrepreneurship Development has been set up as an institutional mechanism to link idle S&T manpower with the unutilised institutional credit facilities; and a consortium of survey organisations is envisaged to undertake exploration of national natural resources in different parts of the country. These steps are contemplated to ensure optimum utilisation of the qualified scientists and technologists in the country.

## Day Light Robberies in Capital

- 551, SHRI K. LAKKAPPA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
- (a) whether there have been day light robberies recently in the capital;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, during the last 6 months;
- (c) whether some, young boys are involved in these crimes; and
- (d) the action contemplated by Government to minimise such robbe-

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFARS AND DEPARTMENT OF PARLAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI P. VENKATA-SUBBHAIAH): (a) and (b). Puring the last six months viz. from 1-8-1981 to 31-1-1982, 25 such cases have been reported.

- (c) Out of the 35 persons arrested in these cases, 21 are below the age of 25.
- (d) The following steps have been taken to curb such crimes:-
  - (i) Increased police vigilance.
  - (ii) Intensive foot and mobile patrolling including armed patrolling with walkie-talkie sets and wireless fitted niotorcycles.

- (iii) Action under the normal preventive sections of Cr. P.C. against bad characters and criminals.
- (iv) Continuous drives by the special squade of the districts to detect dacoits robbers and other bad characters by developing intelligence.
- (v) Surprise checking of the vehicles to detect those involved in commission of crimes:
- (vi) Strengthening of surveillance over known criminals.
- (vii) Organisation of Thikri Pehra and patrolling by local residents and private chowkidars; in coordination with police patrol pickets.
- (viii) Special watch on released eriminals.
- (ix) Posting of pickets at vulnerable points.
- (x) Placing of barriers at selected and strategic places.
- (xi) Stepping up of externment proceedings.
- (xiii) Inter-Districts meetings with the Police Officials of the other adjoining States.

## Bonded Labour

- (a) whether Government received any report from the States regarding the incidence of bonded labour;
- (b) if so, names of these States and the number of such labourers; and
- (c) steps taken by Government to rehabilitate them, details thereof?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE LABOUR (SHRI MINISTRY OF DHARMAVIR): (a) and (b). The incidence of bonded labour system has been reported from ten States, viz., Bihar, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh. A statement showing, State-wise and year-wise, the number of bonded labourers identified, released and rehabilitated, 31-12-1981, is attached (Annexure I).

(c) The Act is implemented by the State Governments with a view to supplementing the States' efforts and accelerating the process of rehabilitation of freed bonded labourers, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme was introduced in 1978-79 under which maching assistance, on 50:50 basis, is provided to the States for the rehabilitation of the bonded labourers. A statement indicating funds released under the Scheme, upto 31-12-81, is attached (Annexure II).
