Facilities for Overhauling Locomotives

1349. Shrimati Mafida Ahmed: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) the names of station where facilities for overhauling locomotives, passenger bogies and wagons exist in Assam section of N.E.F. Railway,

(b) whether any overhauling work is pending at present; and

(c) the date by which, it will be completed?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri Shahnawaz Khan): (a) to (c). A statement furnishing the required information is placed on the Table.

Deraiment of Passenger Train between Kotalpukur and Pakur

1350. Shri Raghunath Singh: Will the Minister of Railways be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that on the 20th October, 1958, the Gaya-Sealdah

Passenger train was derailed between Kotalpukur and Pakur stations; and

(b) if so, the causes of the derailment?

The Deputy Minister of Railways (Shri S. V. Ramaswamy): (a) Yes. On 20-10-1958 at about 22:20 hours while No. 338 Down Gaya-Sealdah Passenger train was on run, the engine of the train derailed between Kotalpukur and Pakur stations of Eastern Railway. There were no casualties.

(b) A Senior Scale Officers Committee investigated the accident. The report of the Committee is under examination.

Research Schemes for Bombay
