

Oil Jetty at Haldia Port

3176. PROF. SATYAGOPAL MISRA: Will the Minister of SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:

(a) whether his Ministry has received the final clearance from the Ministry of Planning for setting up of another oil jetty at Haldia Port Complex during the Sixth Plan period;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) and (b). A provision of Rs. 6.00 crores has been made in Sixth Plan 1980-85 for construction of Second Oil Jetty at Haldia. An investment decision is yet to be taken.

(c) A Detailed Project Report is being prepared.

रेल मंत्रालय तथा संसदीय कार्य विभाग में उपमंत्री (श्री मल्लिकार्जुन) : (क) जी, नहीं। अप लाइन के पुल का निर्माण 1865 में किया गया था और 1929 में इस पर फिर से गर्डर लगाये गये थे। डाउन लाइन के पुल का निर्माण 1913 में किया गया था। ये दोनों पुल यातायात के लिए निरापद हैं।

Rechecking of mark in 1982 Delhi S.S.C. Examination

3179. SHRI K. C. SHARMA: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) number of candidates who applied for rechecking of their marks in the Delhi Senior School Certificate Examination 1982 conducted by the C.B.S.E.;

(b) the time taken for their disposal and the number of cases in which errors were found;

(c) what care is taken against the wrong evaluation of the answer books while rechecking the answer books; and

(d) whether Government propose to introduce the system of re-evaluation so that justice is done to the students who suffer at the hands of the examiners?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) and (b). 1077 candidates applied for re-checking of their marks in one to five subjects in the Delhi Senior School Certificate Examination, 1982. Errors were detected in 14 cases. The Central Board of Secondary Education, ordinarily, takes two to three weeks to dispose of such cases.

(c) Re-checking of marks is supervised by a senior officer of the Board.

(d) No, Sir.

THE MINISTER OF SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) The Ministry of Shipping and Transport has no Special Component Plan.

Finalisation of Indian Team for Asiad-82

3181. SHRI KAMAL NATH: Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND CULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Indian teams for various events for Asiad-82 have been finalised; and

(b) arrangements made for coaching the players for Asiad-82?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) The Indian Olympic Association who are responsible for the selection of Indian teams for Asiad-1982 have informed the Government that Indian teams for various events of 9th Asian Games 1982 have not yet been finalised.

(b) India will be taking part in all the 21 disciplines included in the IX Asian Games. India will also be participating in Kabaddi which is one of the two demonstration games approved for the Games. Training schedules formulated by the National Sports Federations in consultation with the Netaji Subhash Institute of Sports, Patiala and with the approval of All India Council of Sports and the Coaching Monitoring Committee set up by the Government under the Chairmanship of Shri R. N. Mirdha., M.P., to prepare our sportsmen and women for participation in the 9th Asian Games are under implementation. 175 coaching camps have been conducted up to 30-6-82. The training is being imparted by senior coaches of NIS and foreign coaches whose services have been obtained at the request of National Sports Federations. Necessary imported sophisticated sports equipment and sports training films and indigenous equipment are being used in training of the teams. Opportunities for exposure to international competitions abroad as well as in India are also being provided as and when necessary. Physical facilities have been created by way of 5 new indoor halls at NIS, Patiala, by laying Synthetic Track in
