for the development of various cottage and small industries during 1959-60. In addition to this the Khadi and Village Industries Commission has disbursed, during 1959-60, Rs. 57,26,215 as grants and Rs. 1,01,09,523 as loans to Registered Institutions, Cooperative Societies and State Board in Andhra Pradesh for the development of Khadi and village industries.
