

(b) whether any other lump sum grants were given to Orissa in 1958-59 and 1959-60 for medical education and training under Centrally sponsored schemes; and

(c) if so, what amount and for what schemes?

The Minister of Health (Shri Karmarkar): (a) A sum of Rs. 12,94,656 (excluding the lump sum grants) has so far been sanctioned to the Government of Orissa, during the Second Five Year Plan period for the expansion of the S.C.B. Medical College, Cuttack.

(b) and (c). In accordance with the revised procedure for the release of Central assistance to State Governments, during 1958-59, a sum of Rs 14.175 lakhs was sanctioned to the Government of Orissa as lump sum grant for the group "Medical Education and Training". During 1959-60 a sum of Rs. 9.42 lakhs was sanctioned to the State Government as lump sum grant for all the Centrally sponsored schemes. A list of such schemes is placed on the Table. [See Appendix I, annexure No. 14.]

Forest Development in Orissa

The Minister of Agriculture (Dr. P. S. Deshmukh): The amount allotted to Orissa Government during the Second Five Year Plan period for forest development was Rs. 52.74 lakhs as shown below:—

(a) whether a South Indian Association has approached New Delhi Municipal Committee about change of name of Curzon Road; and

(b) if so, the decision arrived at?

The Minister of Health (Shri Karmarkar): (a) Yes. The National Cultural Organisation, New Delhi, approached the New Delhi Municipal Committee for changing the name of Curzon Road as Sant Tyagaraj Road.

(b) The New Delhi Municipal Committee is not in favour of re-naming of the Curzon Road. The case of re-naming the roads in New Delhi is under consideration of the Committee in a consolidated form and it will be kept in view by the Committee as to which road be named after Sant Tyagaraj.
