#### Drainage Channel from Dalnadi to Surlake

The Orissa Government have reported that an estimate amounting to Rs. 3,72,500 for making a cut from Dalnadi to Surlake through Ganidob village has been sanctioned and that the land required for the work has been acquired. They have also stated that work on the old Surlake portion has been taken in hand, while the work on other portions can be taken up only after the flood season of 1960.
