

(b) There is no separate allocation of funds for the Universities and Colleges in respect of schemes under items (1) and (2) above. However under these schemes funds to the extent of Rs. 10.33 lakhs were sanctioned during 1959-60 to the State Governments for giving grants to the Educational Institutions of the standard of high|higher secondary school and above and another sum of Rs. 20 lakhs is to be allocated during the current financial year for the same purpose.

Under scheme No. (3), a sum of Rs. 19,000 was sanctioned to the Universities and Colleges during the year 1959-60 and during 1960-61 funds amounting to Rs. 24,500 have been sanctioned so far.

Unions Recognised by Government
